

# Wilmington Historical Society Programs and Events for 2021



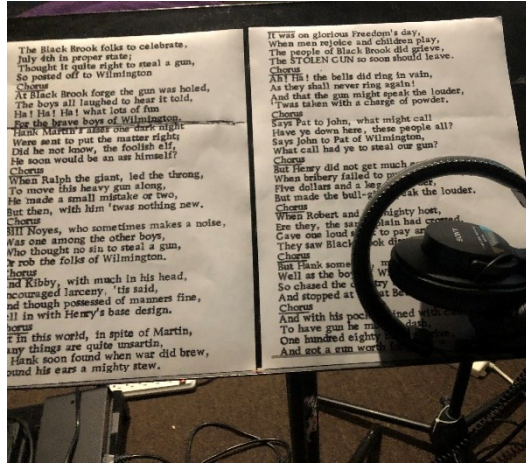
